Description of location of land	The lighthouse is located on the Isle of May, in the Firth of Forth which is an extremely exposed maritime environment. The island is 57ha and slopes from a rocky east coast to high cliffs on the west, the lighthouse sitting in an open location at the centre of the island, surrounded by rough grassland, about 40m to the east of the early 19 th century lighthouse which has replaced it.

4 Summary of proposed works (max 20 words)

Removal and replacement of existing failed coatings to walls, conservation of decorative panel and replacement of door and window.
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5 Description of proposed works

All remaining existing cementitious renders and paint coatings are to be carefully removed with hand tools unless their removal would cause damage to the underlying masonry. The existing masonry is then to be repointed/dubbed/rebuilt out as required using a lime mortar mix which is to match the existing mortar mix as far as possible. Any sound lime-based mortar is to be retained. The finish is to

be flush or slaister pointed to match existing, pinning stones are to be retained and reused when repointing.

All existing impermeable coatings to the decorative panel are to be removed by a specialist stone conservator and then the panel is to be recoated with a suitable coating.

Failed coatings to dressed stonework are to be removed and replaced by an experienced masonry contractor. In addition the cementitious harl to the door surround is to be carefully removed.

The existing door is to be replaced to match existing, constructed from durable European oak coated with a suitable paint, and the frame is to be repaired. A new 6-over-6 traditional sash and case window is to be installed where the previous window has been lost, it is to also be European oak with a suitable paint coating.
