the owners of the Monument known as Old Kirkhill Castle contained within a rectangular area of ground lying immediately to the south of the modern Castle and measuring 45 feet on each of its east-north-east and west-south-west sides and 40 feet on each of its south-south-east and west-north-west sides, the south-westmost point of said area being situated 200 yards south-east of the Bush Burn at its nearest point, 220 yards north-north-east of the northmost corner of the Parish Church of Colmonell and 120 yards east-north-east of Bench Mark 126.5 on the west side of the public road from Colmonell to Ballantrae,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the subjects parts of the lands of Kirkhill

situated in the Parish of Colmonell and County of Ayr described in the Disposition in favour of the said [REDACTED] recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines applicable to the County of Ayr on the 11th day of February, 1938.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby gives you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

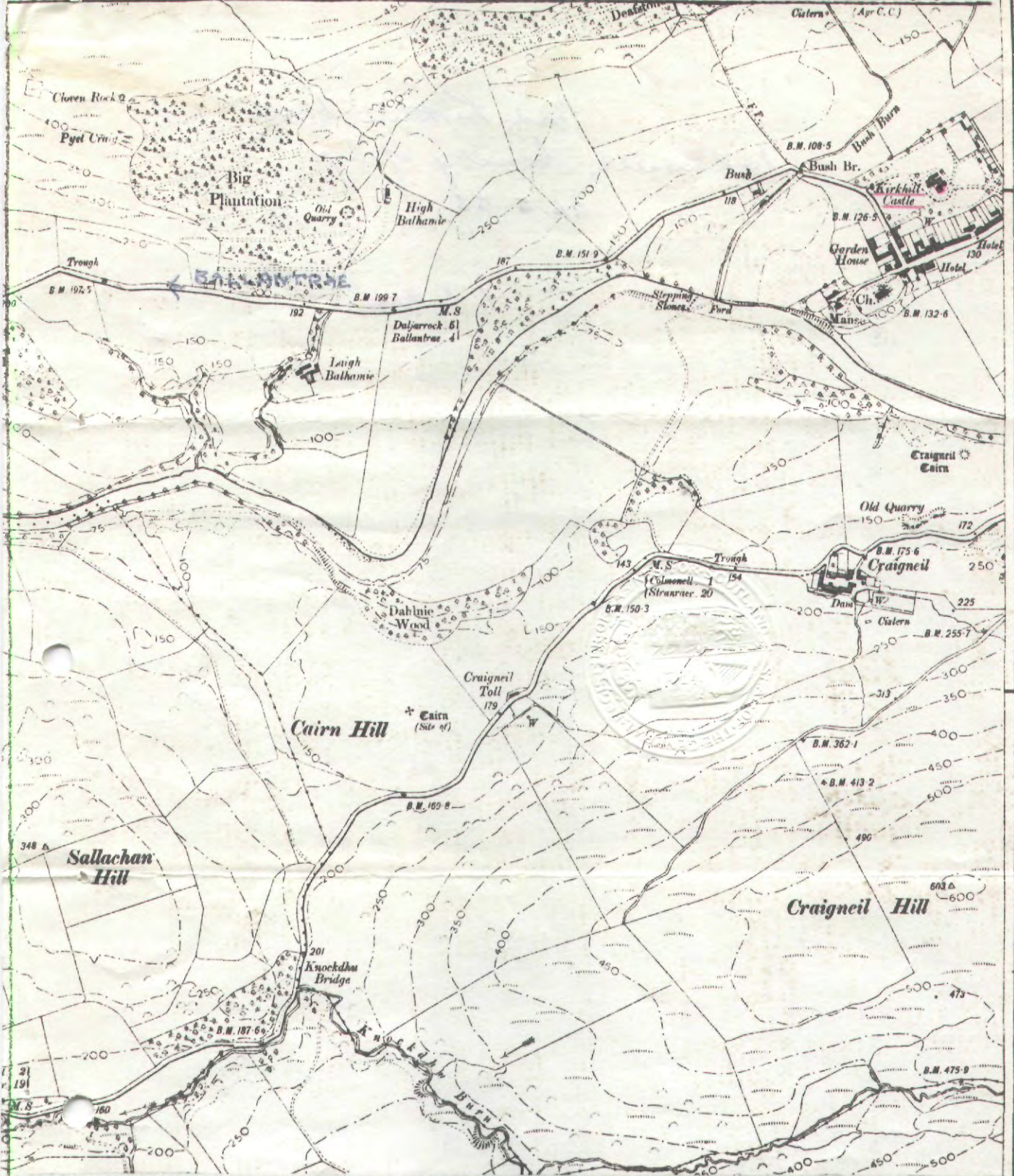
