IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.



the owners of the Monument known as Portincross or Portencross Castle contained within a rectangular area of ground measuring 58 feet on each of its north by east and south by west sides and 31 feet on each of its east by north and west by south sides, the south-eastmost point of said area being situated 70 yards west of the public road to West Kilbride at its nearest point 260 yards north-west by west of Bench Mark 18.6 situated on the east side of said public road, and 20 yards south-south-west of the High Water Mark on the south side of the Old Harbour of Portencross at its nearest point,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as portions of the lands and estate of Auchenames or Ardneil,

situated in the Parish of West Kilbride, and County of Ayr.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby gives you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

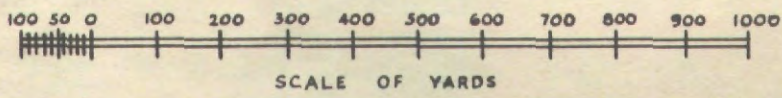
