the owner of the Monuments known as Two stones (fallen), one measuring 11 feet 10 inches in length lying on the south side of a track extending south-westward from the main carriage drive to Achvarasdal Lodge leading south-eastwards from the Road from Reay to Thurso, 60 yards north-east of the kitchen garden there, and the other measuring 11 feet 6 inches in length lying 20 yards to the south of the first stone and outside the north corner of the enclosure rough the Brough at said Lodge being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Achvarasdal Lodge

situated in the Parish of Reay and  
County of Caithness.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act 1913.

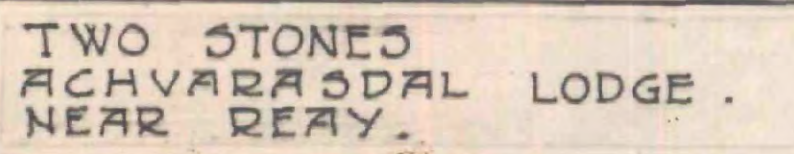

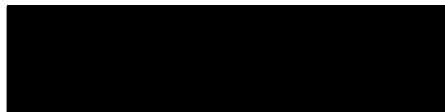
