the owners of the Monument known as "Thing's Wa" (broch or brough) occupying a circular area of ground measuring 100 yards in diameter, the northmost point of said area being situated 460 yards south-east by south of the road between Thurso and Blackheath at its nearest point, 1120 yards east of the north corner of the farm buildings at Blackheath and 310 yards south-south-west at its nearest point of a small burn rising on the south-east slope of Scrabster Hill at the side of said road to the north-east of the Bench Mark 349.6 on the south-east side of said road and flowing in a general east-north-east direction to join the Thurso River,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the Farm and lands of Scrabster

situated in the Parish of Thurso and
County of Caithness.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.
