

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Warehouse, broch and outworks 100m N of, Ulbster comprises a broch with outer defensive works. The area to be scheduled is circular, 70m across but truncated at the N by the Burn of Warehouse so that the maximum N-S dimension is 60m. This area includes the broch, outer defensive line and area of possible ruined structures to the W of the broch. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Latheron and the County of Caithness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

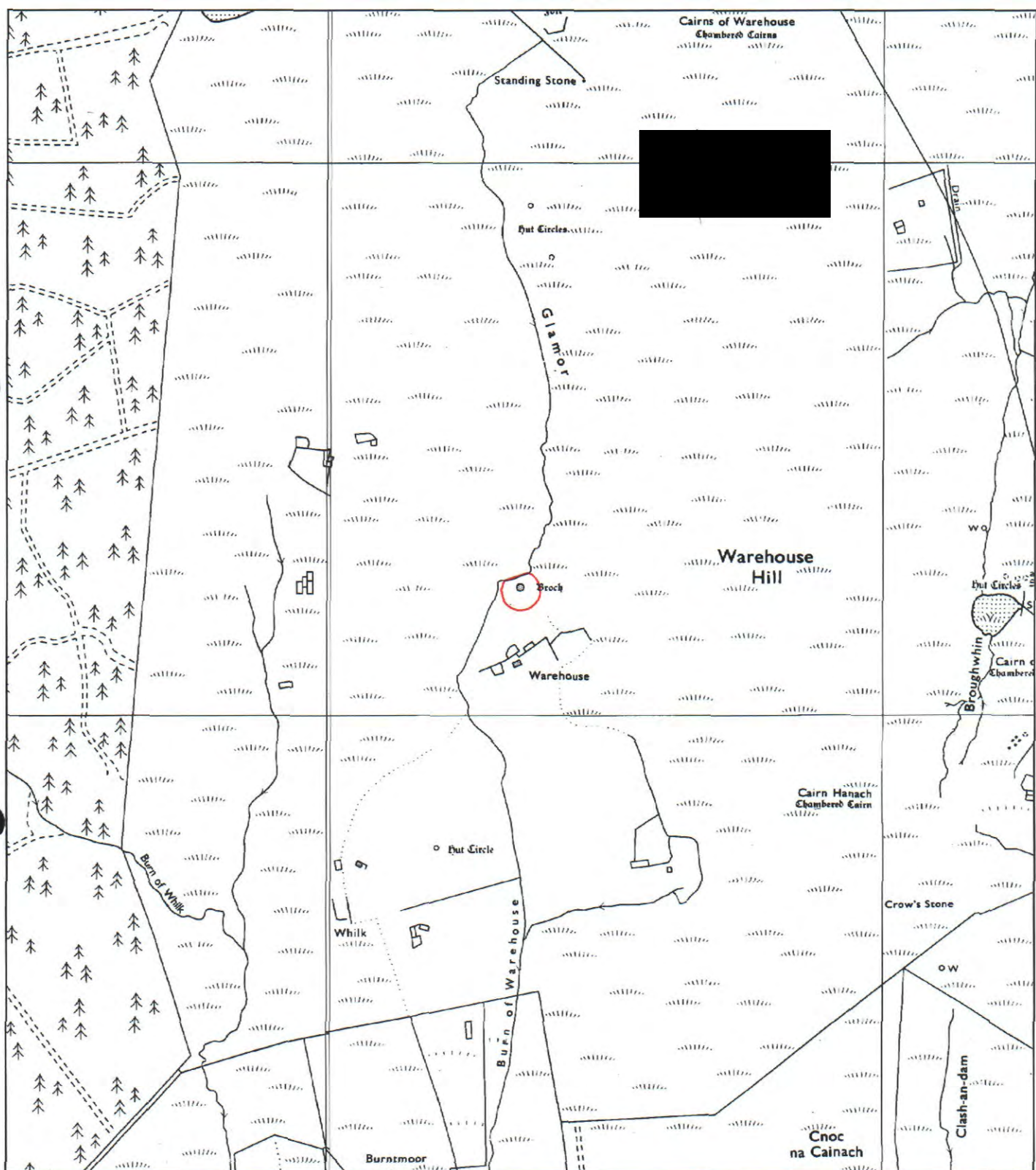
