## THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Warehouse, broch and outworks 100m N of, Ulbster comprises a broch with outer defensive works. The area to be scheduled is circular, 70m across but truncated at the N by the Burn of Warehouse so that the maximum N-S dimension is 60m. This area includes the broch, outer defensive line and area of possible ruined structures to the W of the broch The monument, which lies in the Parish of Latheron and the County of Caithness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto


