the owner of the Monument known as the remains of the Castle called the Bass Castle contained within an area of ground upon the Bass Rock in the Firth of Forth bounded generally on the South South-West by the high water mark immediately to the west of the West Landing along which it extends 45 yards or thereby and measuring on its west, north-west, north-north-east and East south-east sides respectively 40 yards or thereby, 85 yards or thereby and 60 yards or thereby, the south-eastmost point of said area being situated 70 yards south south-west of the Eastmost gable of the lighthouse on the said Rock and 50 yards west south-west of the high water mark at the East Landing at its nearest point,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the lands and Estate of North Berwick

situated in the Parish of North Berwick and County of East Lothian.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby give you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

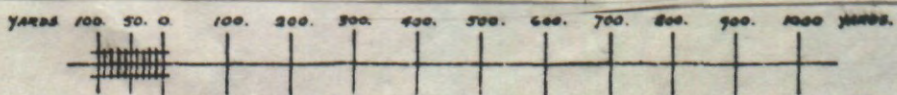
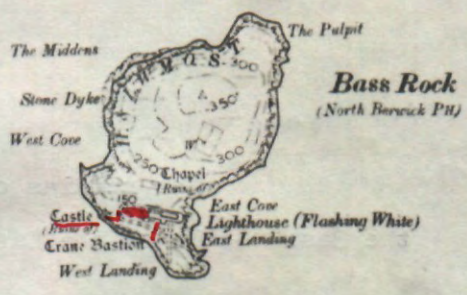
