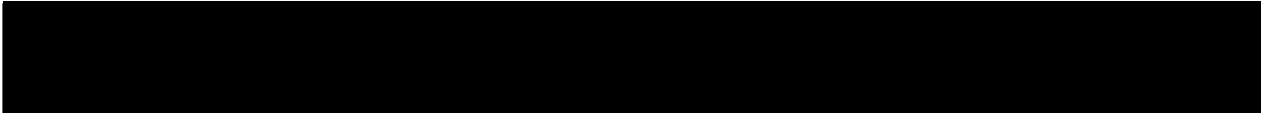

the owners of the Monuments known as Saltcoats Castle and Dovecot consisting of (First) Saltcoats Castle (in ruins) situated immediately east of the cottages at Saltcoats Gardens, 440 yards south by east of the southmost wall of Saltcoats House, 220 yards east by north of the Aberlady and Gullane Branch of the North British Railway now the London and North Eastern Railway at its nearest point and 610 yards north by east of the point where said Railway crosses the Peffer Burn, and (Second) the Dovecot situated to the north-west of said Castle on the East side of the track leading from Saltcoats Gardens to Saltcoats House, 410 yards south by east of said south wall of Saltcoats House and 190 yards east of said Railway Line at its nearest point

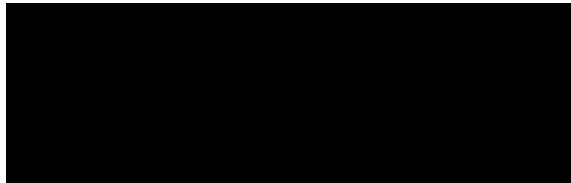
being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as **Luffness Estate**

situated in the Parish of **Dirleton** and
County of **East Lothian.**

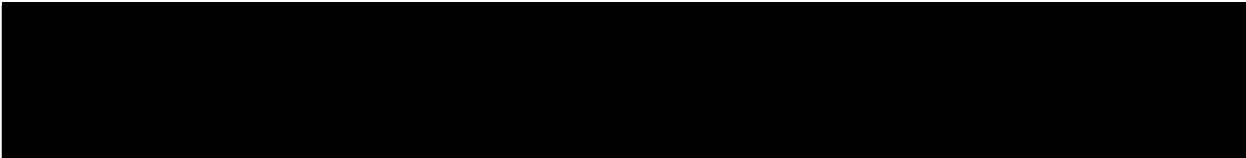

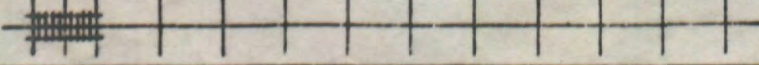
