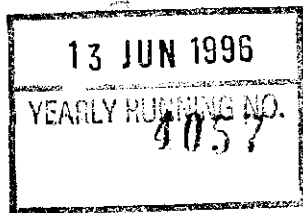

AMENDED ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under Section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument known as Dun Liath, broch, Elgol, dated 8 September 1960 and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Inverness on 30 September 1960 is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the area of the scheduled monument as measuring 40m E-W by 35m N-S, to include the broch and an area around in which traces of activities associated with the construction and occupation of the broch are likely to survive as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

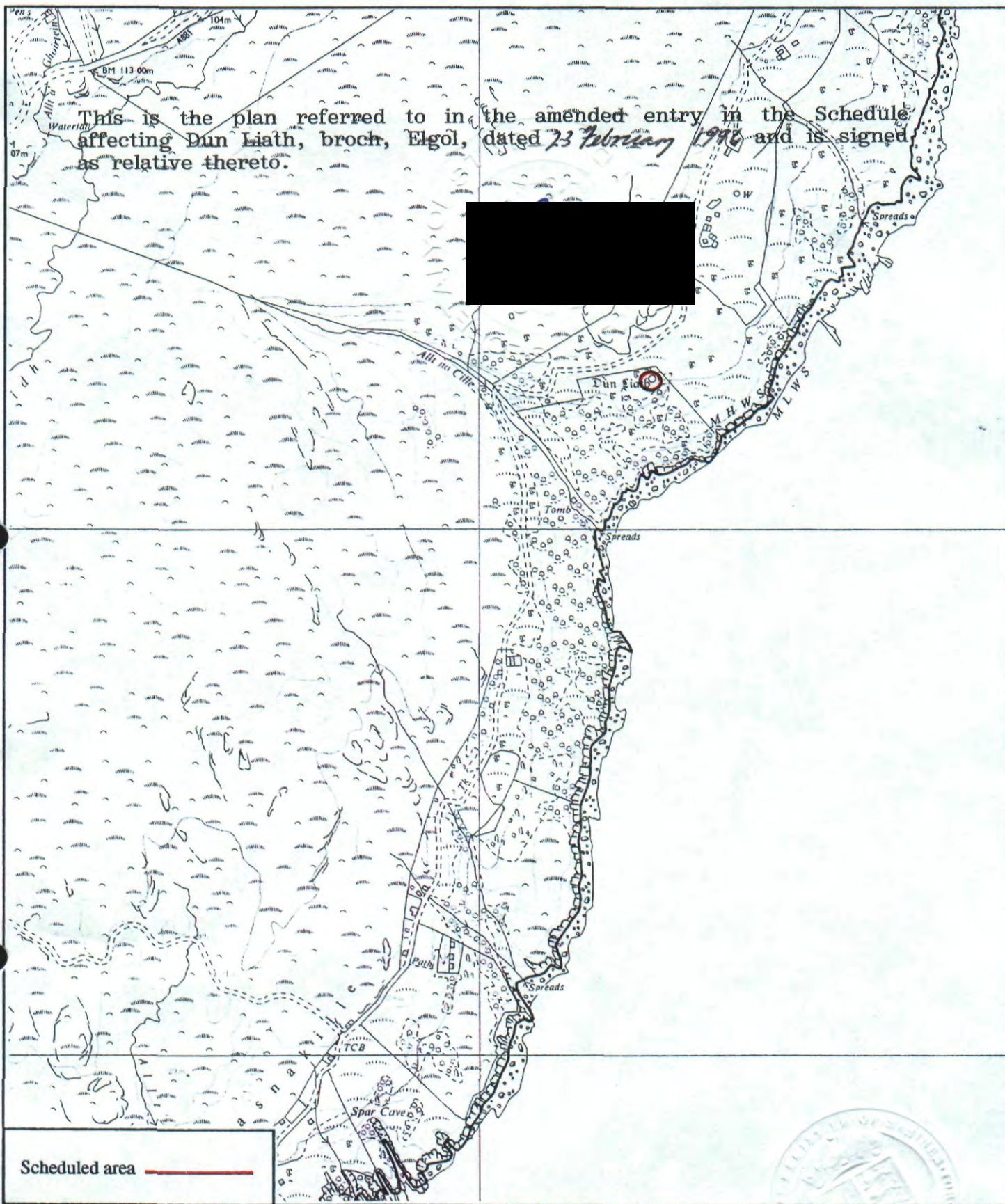

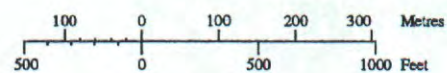
Dun Liath, broch, Elgol
