The entries in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument previously known as Temple Church both dated 26 November and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Midlothian on 20 December both in the year 1971 and now to be known as Temple, Old Parish Church, are hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the area of the scheduled monument as measuring 46m NW-SE and 48m NE-SW as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.


