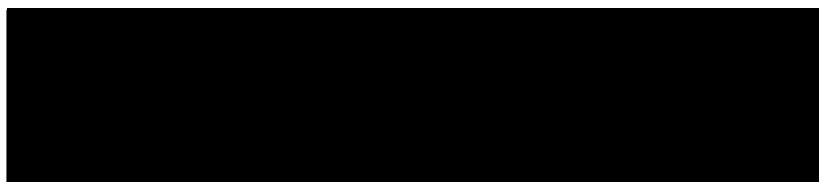

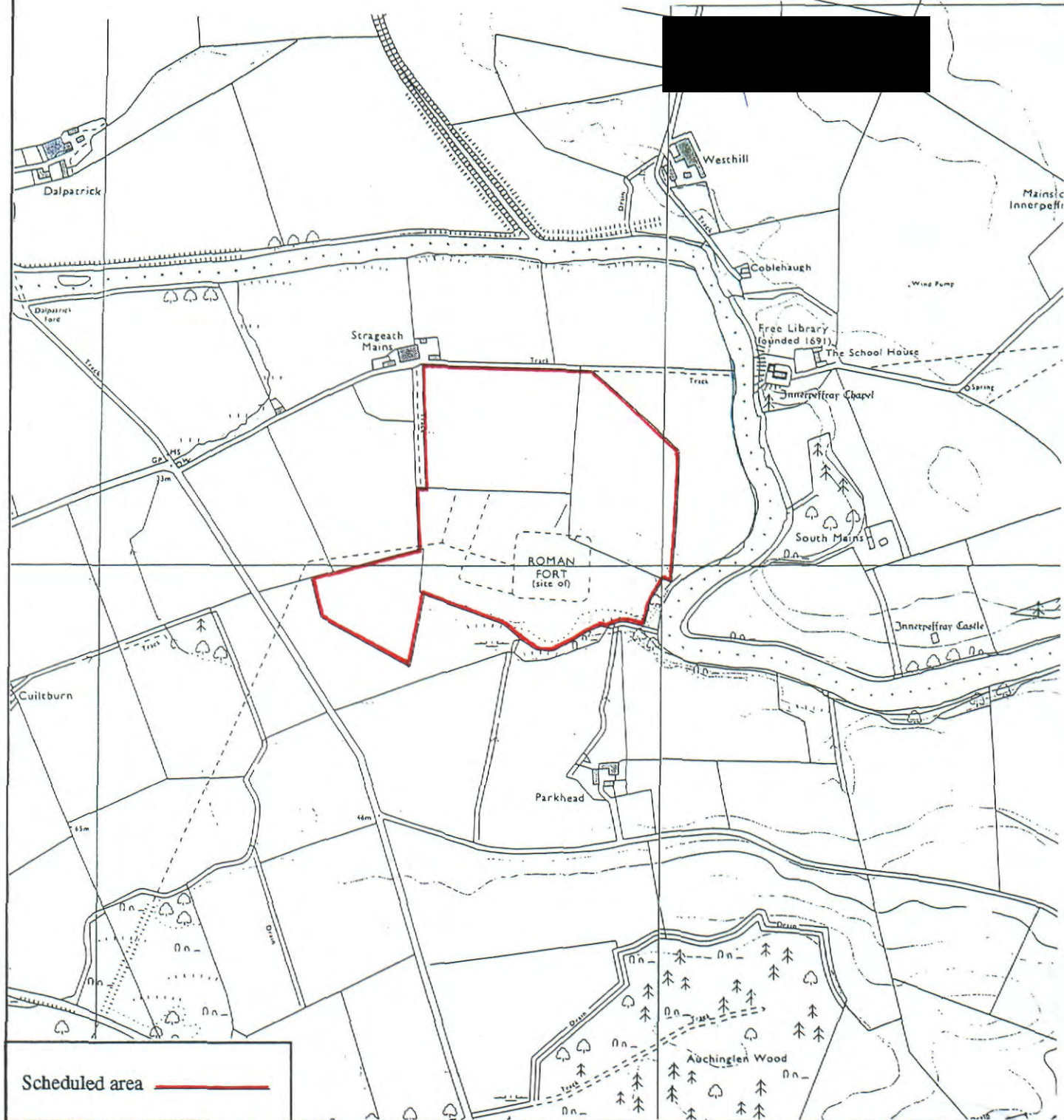

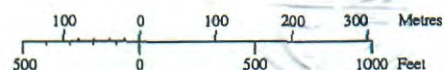
Strageath Mains, Roman fort,
