

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Struan Church, St Fillan's Church and cross-slab comprises a cross-incised slab to the south-west of the present parish church, within the churchyard, and the site of the medieval church dedicated to St Fillan, to the south of the present parish church built in 1829. The cross-incised slab has a simply incised cross on both its east and west faces. It is known to have been one of a number of early stones associated with the site. The site of the church is visible as the faint outline of a rectangular structure immediately to the south of the church now in use. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which there is high archaeological potential. It is sub-rectangular in shape and measures 50m from ENE to WSW by 15m from NNW to SSE. Any burial lairs within which there are active or residual burial rights are excluded from the scheduled area. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Blair Atholl and the County of Perth as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto


