IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 and 1931.

[redacted] the owner of the Monuments known as (First) cairn, hut circles, and mounds situated within the irregular area of ground south-west of Creag an Amalaigh intersected by the road or track at that point leading in a westerly direction from Cambusmore Lodge to Achinael, said area measuring from its north-eastmost point to its eastmost point 150 yards in a south-east direction, from its eastmost point to its south-eastmost point, 70 yards in a south-south-west direction, from its south-eastmost point to its southmost point 140 yards in a direction west by south, from its southmost point to its north-westmost point, 290 yards in a north-west direction, from its north-westmost point to its north-eastmost point 260 yards in a direction east by south, situated said north-eastmost point 35 yards north-east of said road or track at its nearest point, 610 yards south-east of Achinael and 580 yards east by north of the point where a small burn rising to the north of Cnoc Odhar and flowing in a north-westerly direction joins the Allt Loch an Tairbh and (Second) the hut-circle to the north-west of the north-eastmost point of said irregular area of ground, situated immediately on the north-east side of said road or track, 330 yards south-east of Achinael, and 400 yards east-north-east of the Allt Loch an Tairbh at its nearest point being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being parts of the property known as Cambusvie Farm situated in the Parish of Dornoch and County of Sutherland.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monuments above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

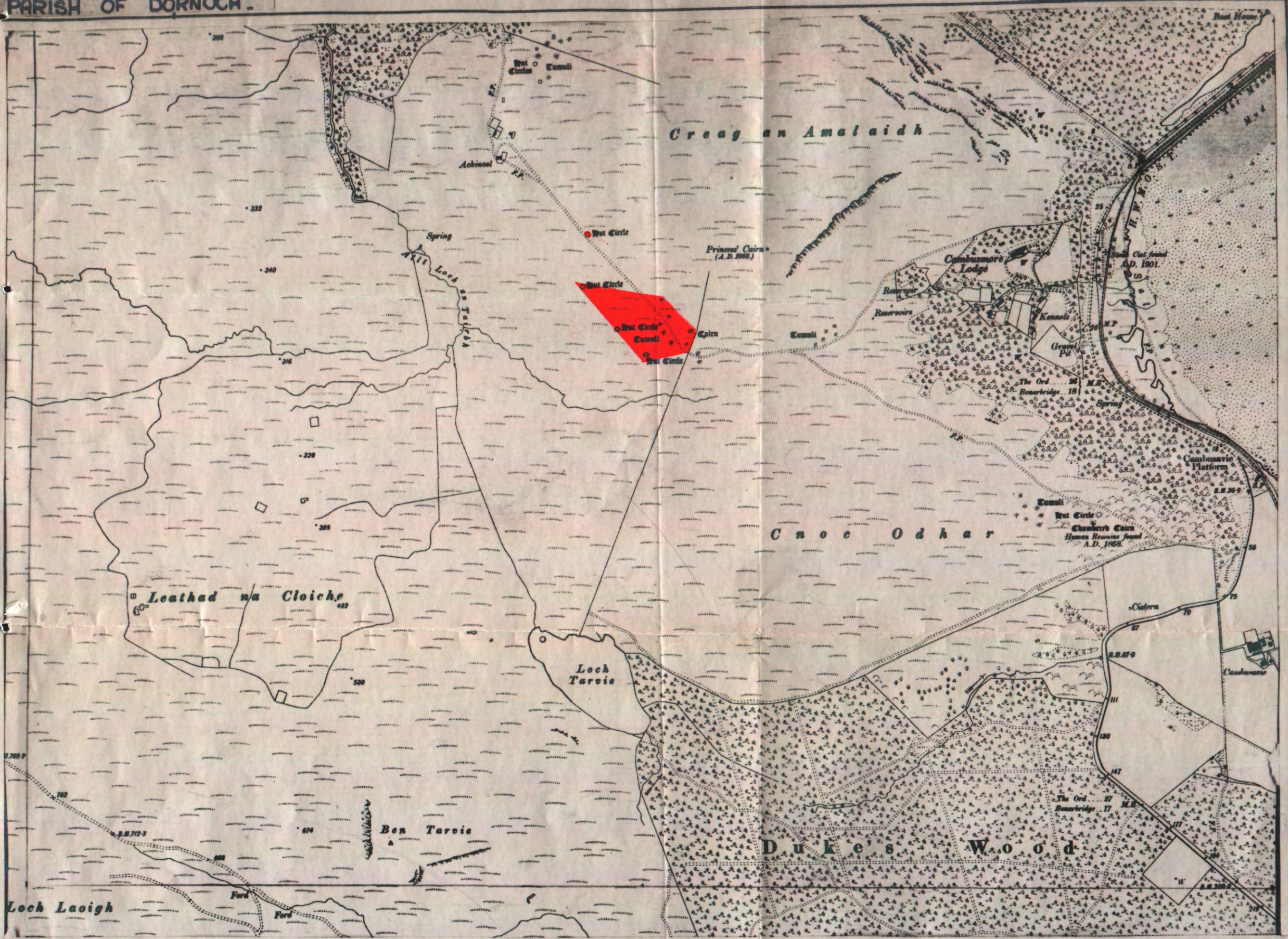
