THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 AMENDED ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under Section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument formerly known as Altbreck, broch N of Lairg, dated 19 February and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Sutherland on 19 March both in the year 1935 is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the monument now known as Altbreck, broch 1650m ESE of Dalchork Bridge, and area of the scheduled monument as measuring 140m NNW-SSE by 65m E-W, to include the broch, the outer enclosure, one of the dykes running S from the broch and an area around in which traces of activities associated with the construction and use of the broch may survive as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.




Altbreck, broch 1650m ESE of Dalchork Bridge
