AMENDED ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under Section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument formerly known as Gallangad Muir, Long cairn, dated 12 September and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Dumbarton on 6 November both in the year 1963 is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the area of the scheduled monument as now being known as Lang Cairn, chambered cairn and cairn, Gallangad Muir and measuring 130m from E to W by 60m transversely, to include the cairns and an area around in which associated remains may survive. as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

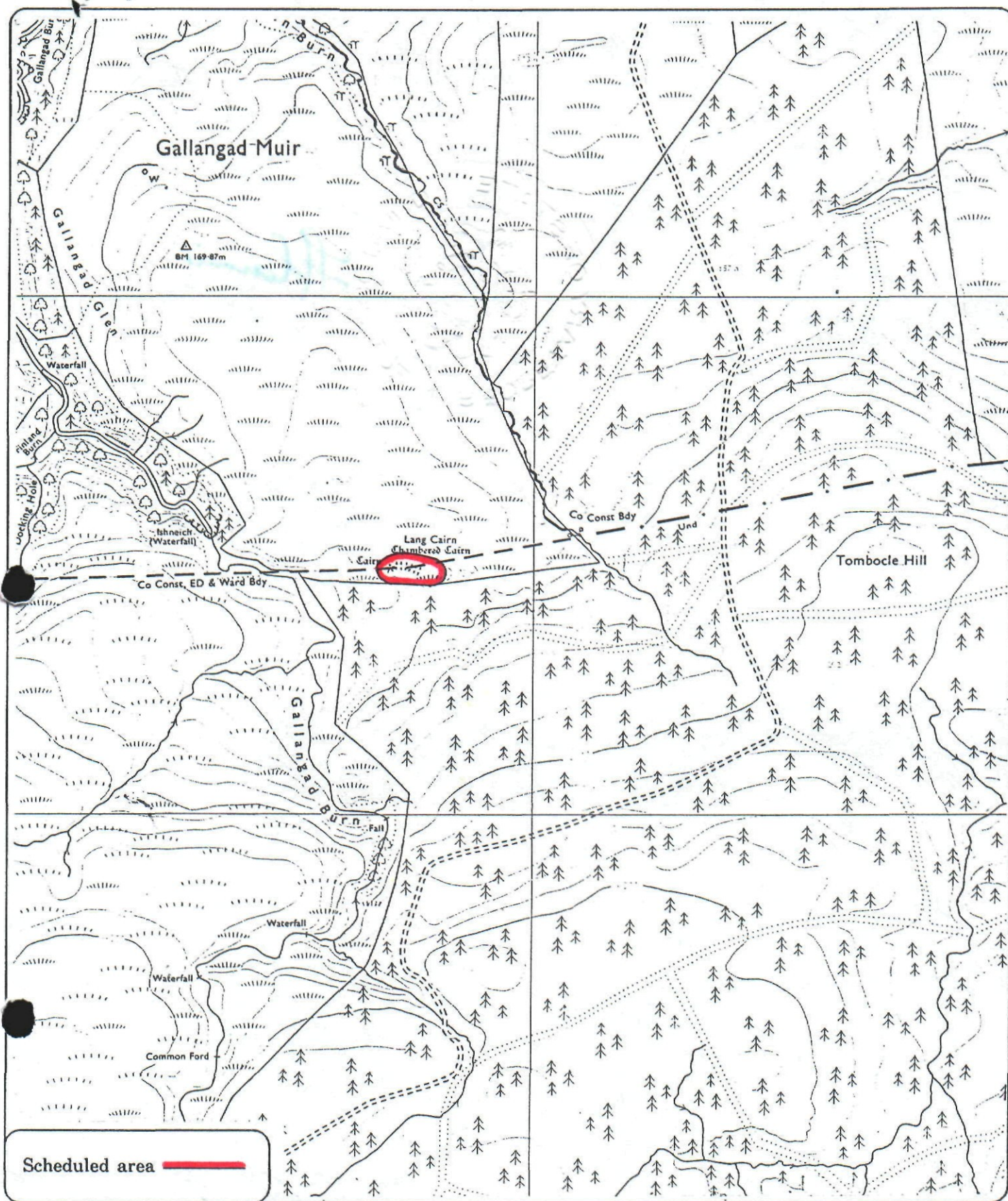

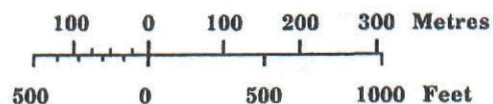
