

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 AMENDED ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under Section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument formerly known as St Abb's Kirk, church, St Abbs Head, dated 6 October 1970 and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Berwick on 2 November 1970 is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the monument now know as St Abb's Kirk, church and monastic remains, St Abbs Head and the area of the scheduled monument as measuring 340m NW-SE by a maximum of 210m transversely, containing the summit plateau of Kirk Hill and the enclosing rampart, as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.
