



THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Holme Mains, motte 210m SE of, comprises a small dome-shaped motte that lies on a promontory above the Holm Burn. The motte has a diameter of 14m and rises to a maximum height of 5m. A section of well defined ditch with a width of 8m, and with an upcast rampart along its outer edge, runs around the eastern segment. The area to be scheduled is irregular on plan, to include the remains described and an area around in which evidence for their construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Inverness and Bona and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.
