ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Callachy Hill, cairn 450m NE of Flowerburn House comprises a round cairn measuring 14m in diameter and 1.8m high. Five excavation trenches have been cut into the cairn but the bulk of it is undisturbed. The area to be scheduled measures 35m in diameter and includes the structures described above and an area in which will survive traces of activities associated with the construction and use of the cairn. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Rosemarkie and the County of Ross and Cromarty as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

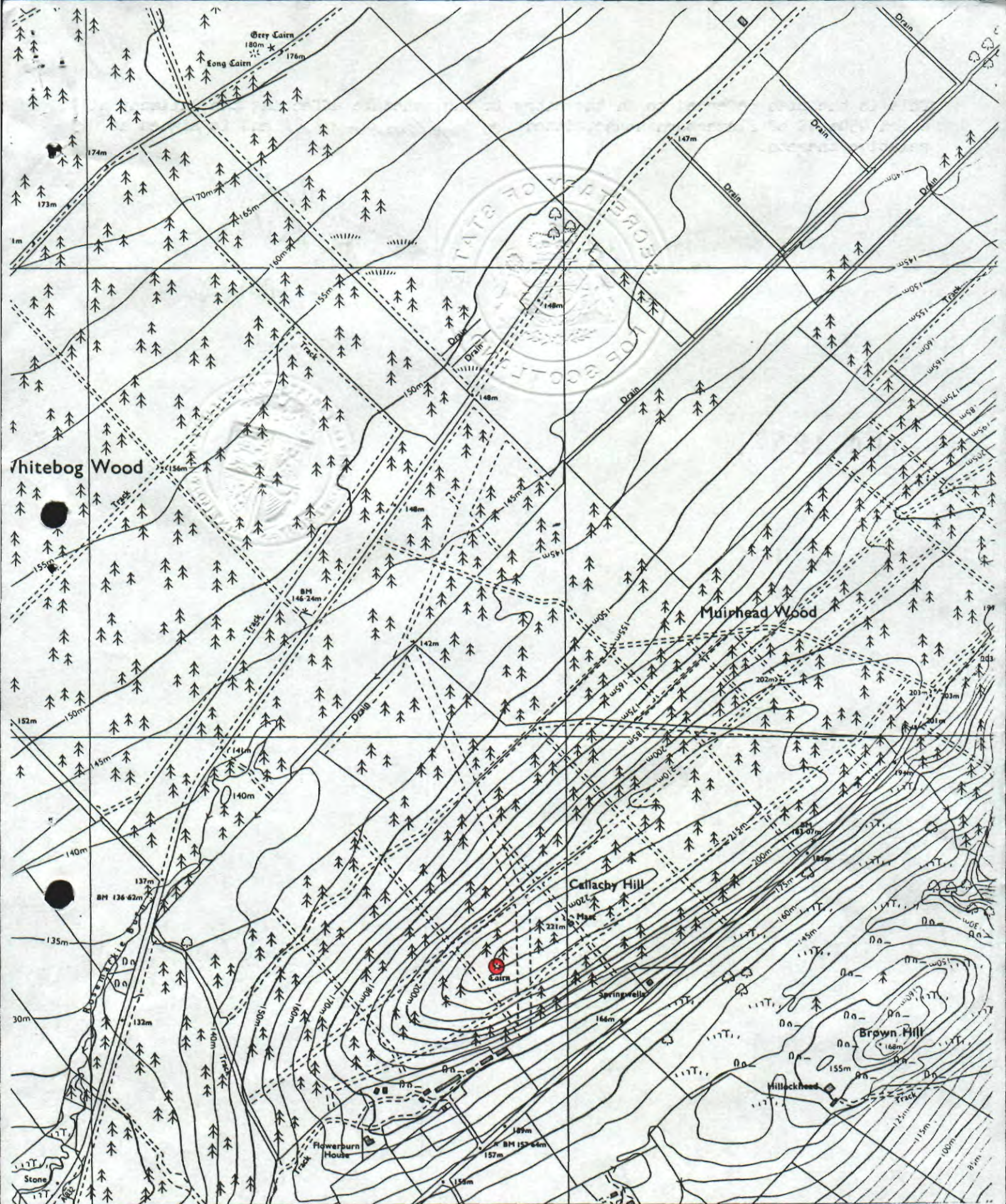

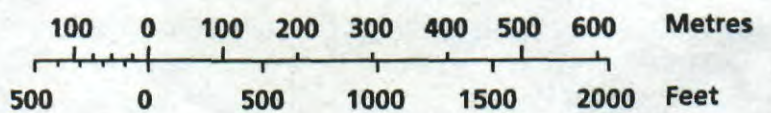
