The monument known as Loch Tigh na Creige, house 200m N of E end of comprises a roofless croft house measuring 24m EW by 5m with a 5m long extension at the W end and an attached 10m radius semicircular sheepfold. Its walls are mortared and the original house has a fine set of half cruck sockets in both long walls. The area to be scheduled measures 50m EW by up to 35m NS. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Lairg and the County of Sutherland shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

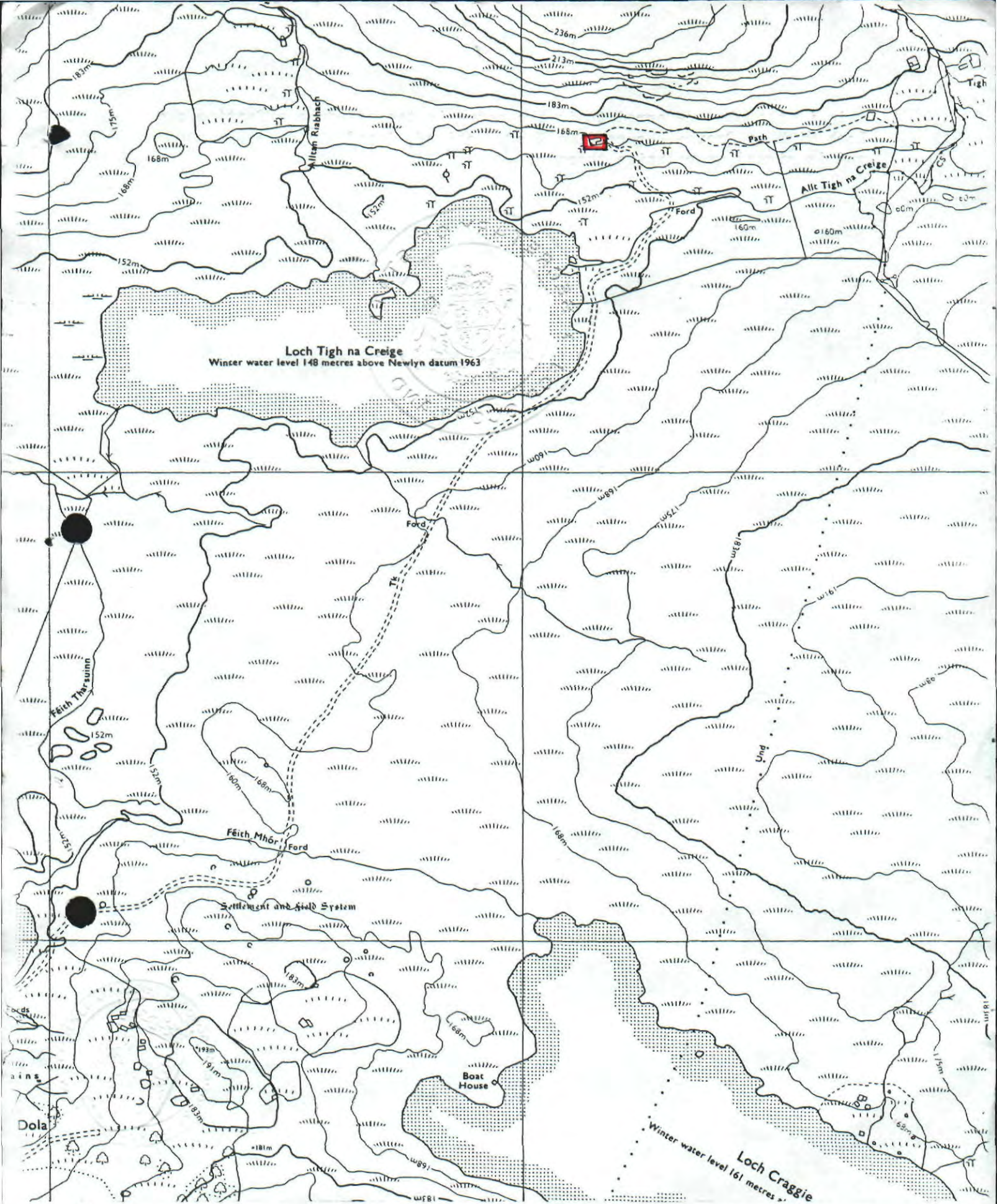

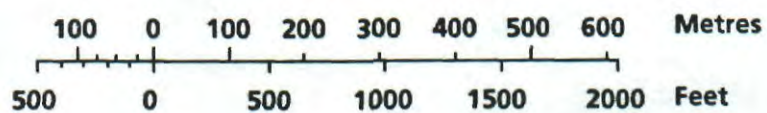
