

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Dun Fionn, fort and cultivation terraces 600m NNE of Clauchlands Farm comprises the remains of a small fort and at least four cultivation terraces, situated, respectively, on the summit and on the southern slope of Dun Fionn. The fort measures 30m E-W by 10m transversely within a well defined earth and stone rampart c 0.6m high and 3m across. The remains of a circular house scoop are visible at the W end of the enclosure. There is a small annex at the E end, measuring c 14m by 10m, with the traces of a defensive ditch beyond. The terraces measure between 4m and 15m across. The area to be scheduled measures a maximum of 190m NW-SE by 130m transversely, to include the fort and the terraces, and an area around, in which traces of activities associated with the use of the fort and terraces will survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kilbride and the County of Bute as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms

is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.


