The monument known as Bravard, cairn, two hut circles and field system 100m N of comprises a cairn measuring 6m in diameter edged with a kerb of stones. Two hut circles: the northernmost is a platform measuring 7m N-S by 9m E-W, with a front revetment 1.1m high; the second is a platform of similar dimensions with an entrance on the east. The field system associated with the house platforms is best preserved to the NW and consists of some well defined linear banks and clearance cairns. The area to be preserved measures 170m E-W by 160m N-S to include the features described above and an area around them in which traces of activities associated with their use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Edderton and the County of Ross and Cromarty as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative


