ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Achadh nan Eun, shieling 1400m N of comprises the remains of a Post Medieval building. The surviving foundations indicate a building of about 9m by 6m on a N-S axis. The building was sited on a grassy mound. The area to be scheduled measures a maximum of 80m E-W and 70m N-S, to include the building and an area around it in which traces of activities associated with its construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Lairg and the County of Sutherland as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects



hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

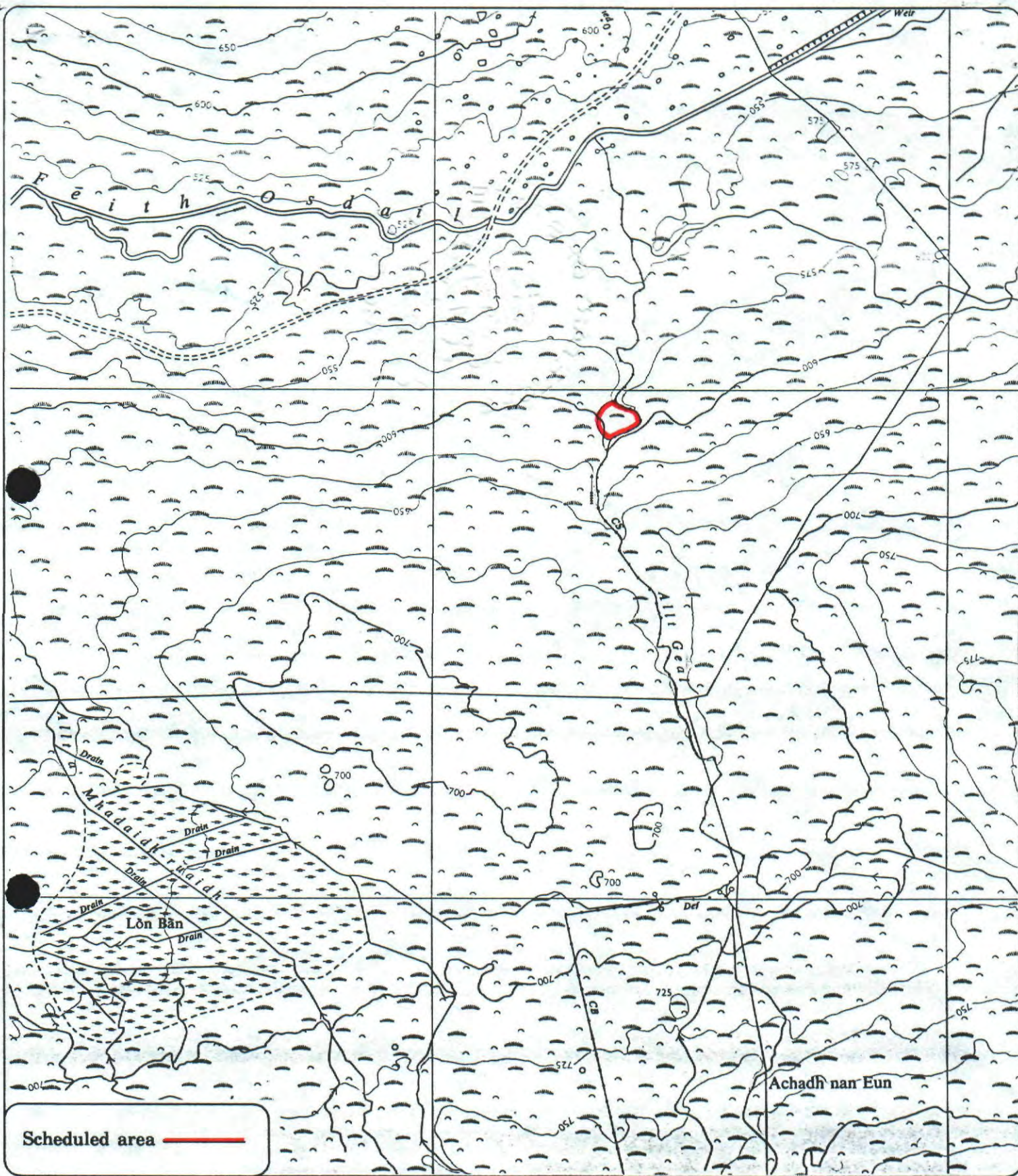

Scheduled area ———

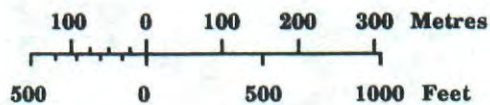
