The monument known as Greentulloch, broch 180m NE of comprises a broch which is estimated to be about 17m in diameter and incorporated into a mound which is about 23m in diameter and 1.5m high. A small trench has been excavated at some time in the past on the SE of the mound and this has exposed the lintelled entrance to the broch and a curved stretch of the outer wall face 8m long. The outer mound extends someway beyond the wall of the broch on the SW and it is probable that ancillary structures outside the broch wall will survive in this area. area to be scheduled measures 65m SW-NE by 50m SE-NW, to include the broch, the outer mound and an area around in which traces of activities associated with the building and occupation of the broch may survive. This area excludes the roofless long house to the SE, is defined by the modern wall to the SW and extends 20m beyond the walled enclosure on the NW and NE. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Latheron and the County of Caithness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects

is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.


