ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Tighcreag, hut circle 500m WSW of comprises a later prehistoric hut circle. The hut circle has been built into the slope and measures 12m E-W by 11m N-S. An entrance survives in the E arc of the hut and the wall is best preserved to the N of this entrance, where it is 2m wide and 0.4m high. The area to be scheduled measures 30m in diameter to include the hut circle and an area around it in which traces of activities associated with its use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Lairg and the County of Sutherland as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and

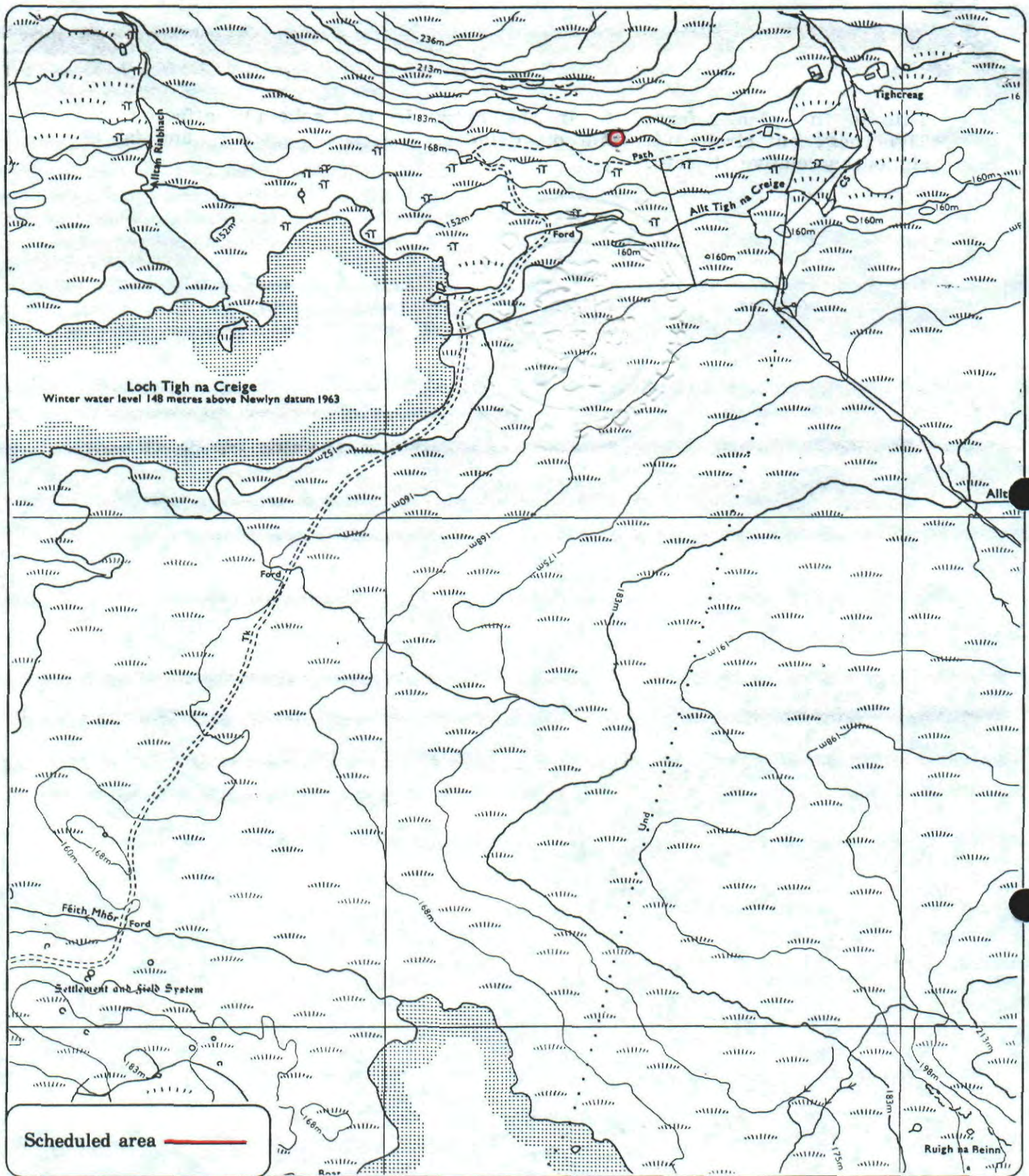

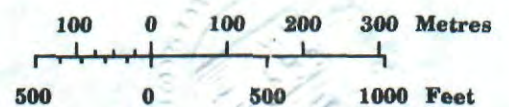
