THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Loedebest, prehistoric burial cairn 500m SSE comprises a cairn with a cist in the centre. The cairn is about 5m in diameter and 0.6m high and a number of slabs are visible forming an edge to the cairn. A cist formed by three stone slabs is exposed in the The cist is 0.9m E-W by 0.4m wide and 0.2m deep. The area to be scheduled measures 25m in diameter, to include the cairn and an area around in which traces of activities associated with its construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Latheron and the County of Caithness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the




Loedebest, prehistoric burial cairn 500m SSE of
