

## THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Latheronwheel House, long cairn 850m SE of comprises a prehistoric long cairn. The area to be scheduled measures 110m SW-NE by 65m SE-NW (maximum), to include the long cairn and an area around it in which traces of activities associated with the building and use of the cairn are likely to survive.
