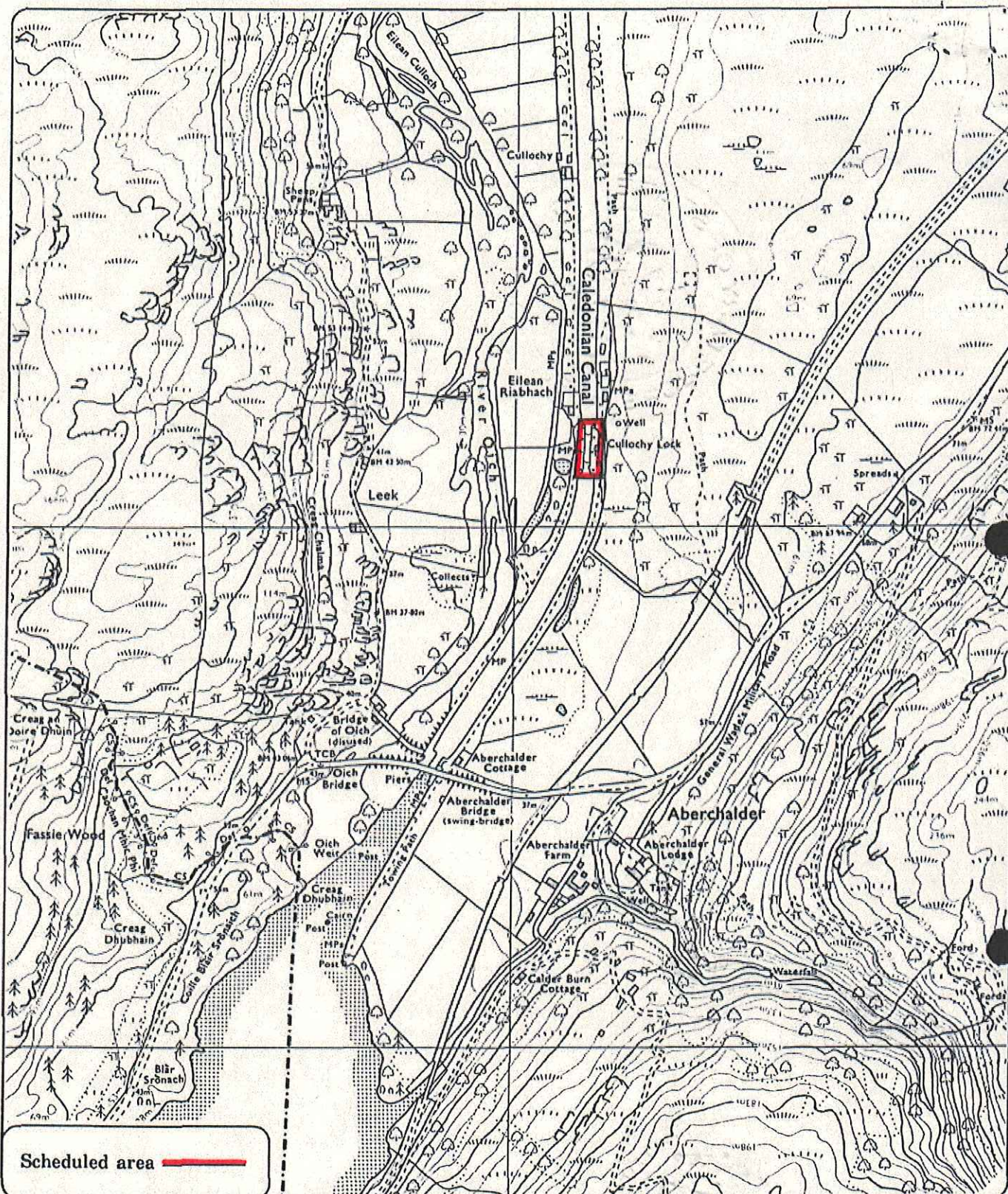

Scheduled area

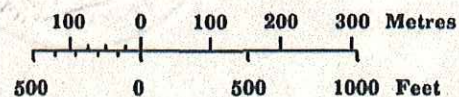
Caledonian Canal, Cullochy Lock
