The monument known as Meikle Kildrummie, enclosure 400m WNW of comprises a prehistoric settlement site. The area to be scheduled measures a maximum of 110m ENE-WSW by 110m NNW-SSE, to include the area in which the crop marks are visible and areas between and around where further features are likely to survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Nairn and the County of Nairn as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part

is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.




