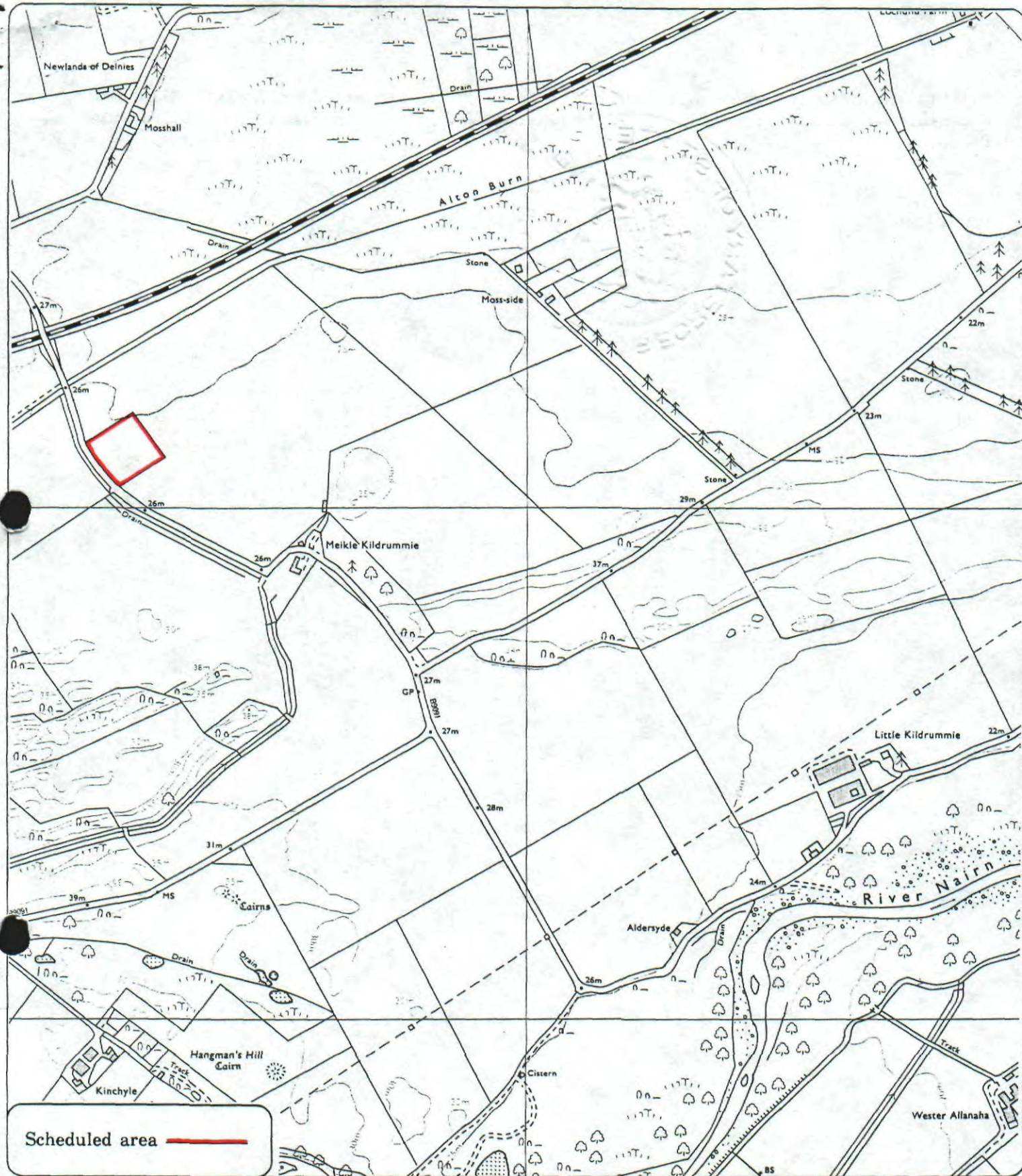

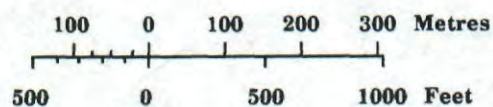
**Meikle Kildrummie, enclosure
