The monument known as Loch Beag na Fuaralachd, prehistoric settlement 950m SW of comprises a "hut circle" (the remains of a round house) and traces of a field system which are located on a S facing hill side. The hut circle measures 9m by 8m within a wall which consists of a rubble spread 2.5m wide and up to 0.7m high. The entrance to the hut circle is on the SE. The field system consists of 12 or more clearance cairns which surround the house and a linear earthwork along the slope to the N. The area to be scheduled measures a maximum of 100m E-W by 70m N-S, to include the foundations of the round house and the field system. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Lairg and the County of Sutherland as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects described in the


