The monument known as Invershin Farm, settlement and burnt mound 1200m E of comprises a hut circle and a burnt mound situated in 2 forestry clearings on a SW-facing hill slope. Two areas are to be scheduled: the NW area is 80m NW-SE by 60m NE-SW, the SE area is 40m NW-SE by 50m WSW-ENE, to include the hut circle, burnt mound and areas around in which traces of activities associated with the construction and use of these monuments may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Creich and the County of Sutherland as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms

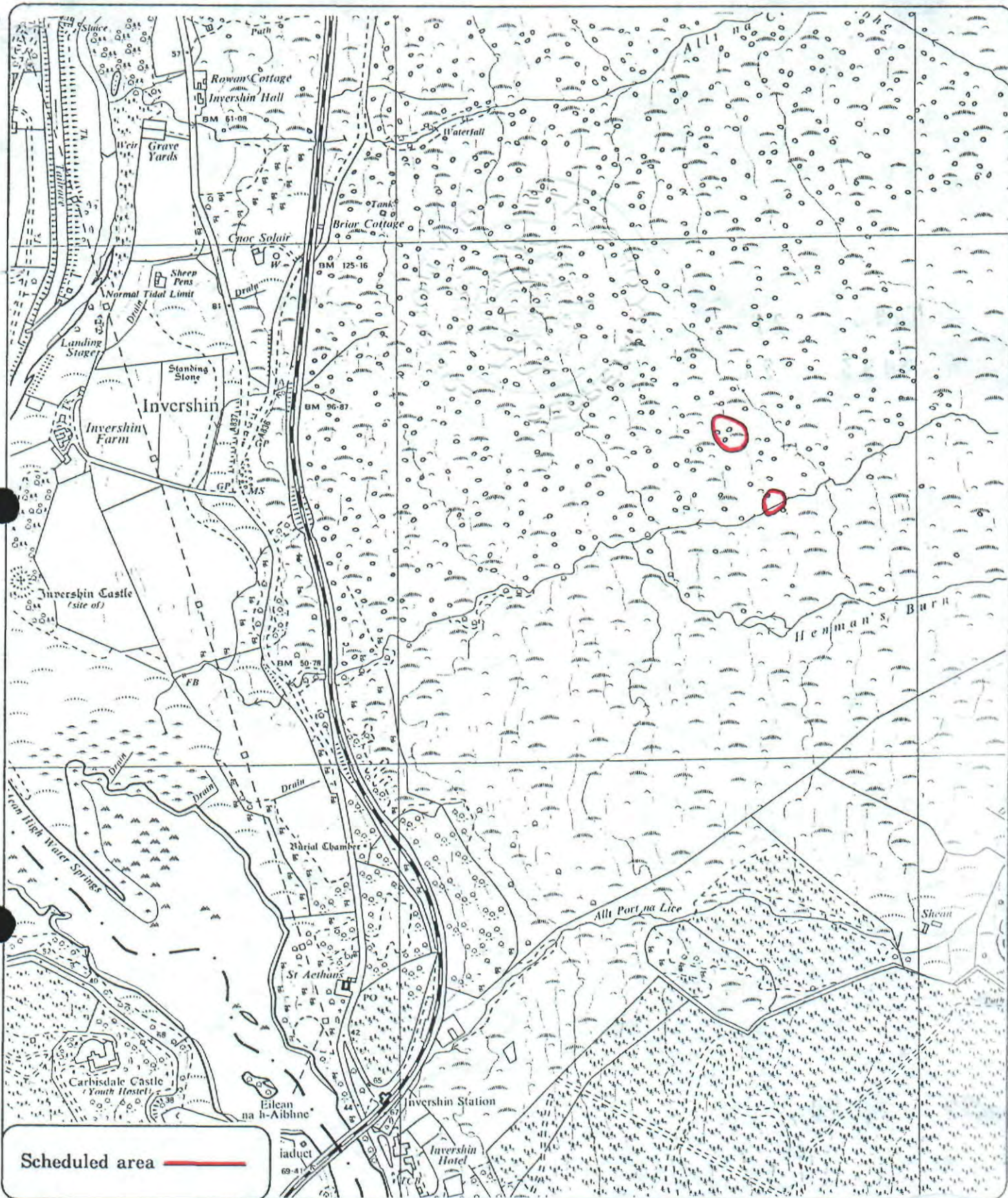

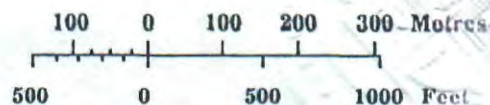
