THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Smoo Cave, prehistoric occupation site comprises deposits related to human occupation which occur on the floor of Smoo Cave. The area to be scheduled measures 35m NNE-SSW by a maximum of 30m WNW-ESE to include the middens and an area to the S and W in which further archaeological deposits may survive below the present floor of the cave. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Durness and the County of Sutherland as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects

included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.






Smoo Cave, prehistoric occupation site
