ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Keil, church, Duror of Appin comprises the remains of a late medieval church and its burial ground situated immediately to the SW of Keil House. The area to be scheduled is that enclosed by the cemetery wall, but excluding that wall itself. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Lismore and Appin and the County of Argyll as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto, is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

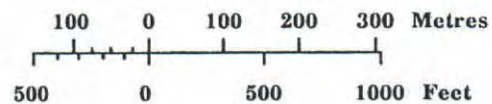
