The monument known as Unish House, house, outbuildings and steading comprises the remains of Unish House, a domestic residence of early seventeenth century date, and the surrounding ancillary buildings, steading and field enclosures. The area to be scheduled is irregular, measuring a maximum of 190m E-W by 165m N-S, to include the laird's house, steading buildings and enclosures. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Duirinish and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms

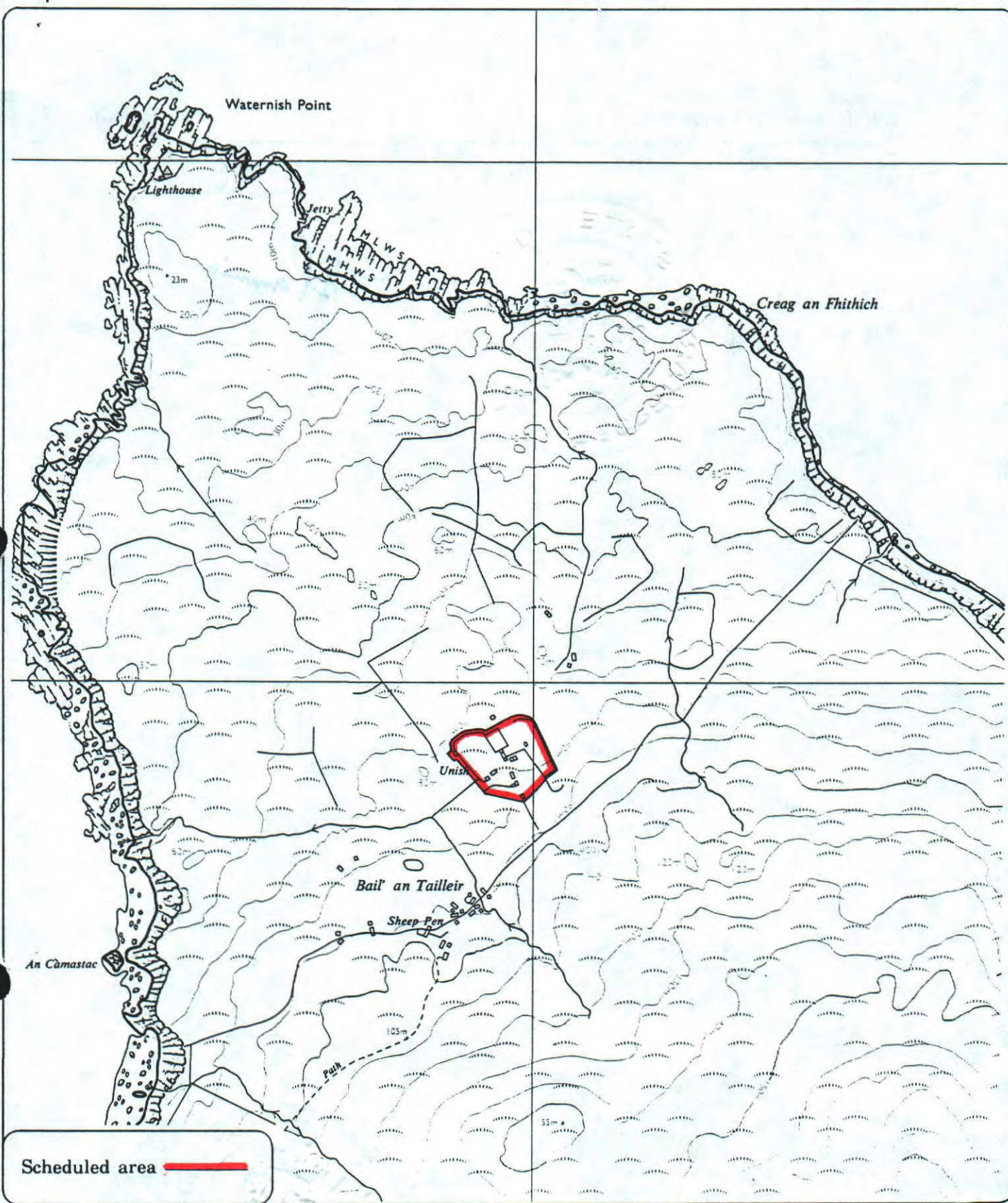

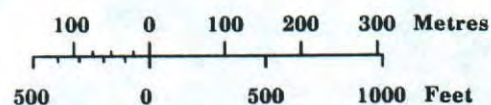
