## THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Cill Chriosd, church and burial ground comprises the remains of the late 16th/early 17th century church of the parish of Strath, known as Cill Chriosd. The area to be scheduled is rectangular, measuring a maximum of 110m NE-SW by 55m NW-SE, to include the church and burial ground, with the exception of the burial enclosure constructed against the E wall of the burial ground. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Strath and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto, is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.




