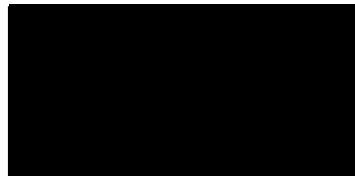
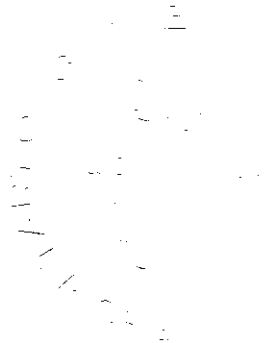

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Balkello, standing stone comprises a standing stone of prehistoric date. The area to be scheduled encompasses the stone and an area around it in which buried deposits relating to the original emplacement and use of the stone may be expected to survive. It is semi-circular with a diameter of 20m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Tealing and the County of Angus as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

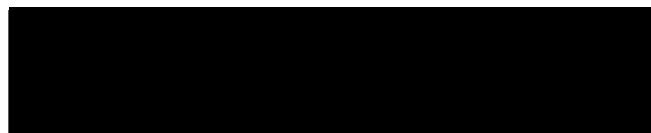

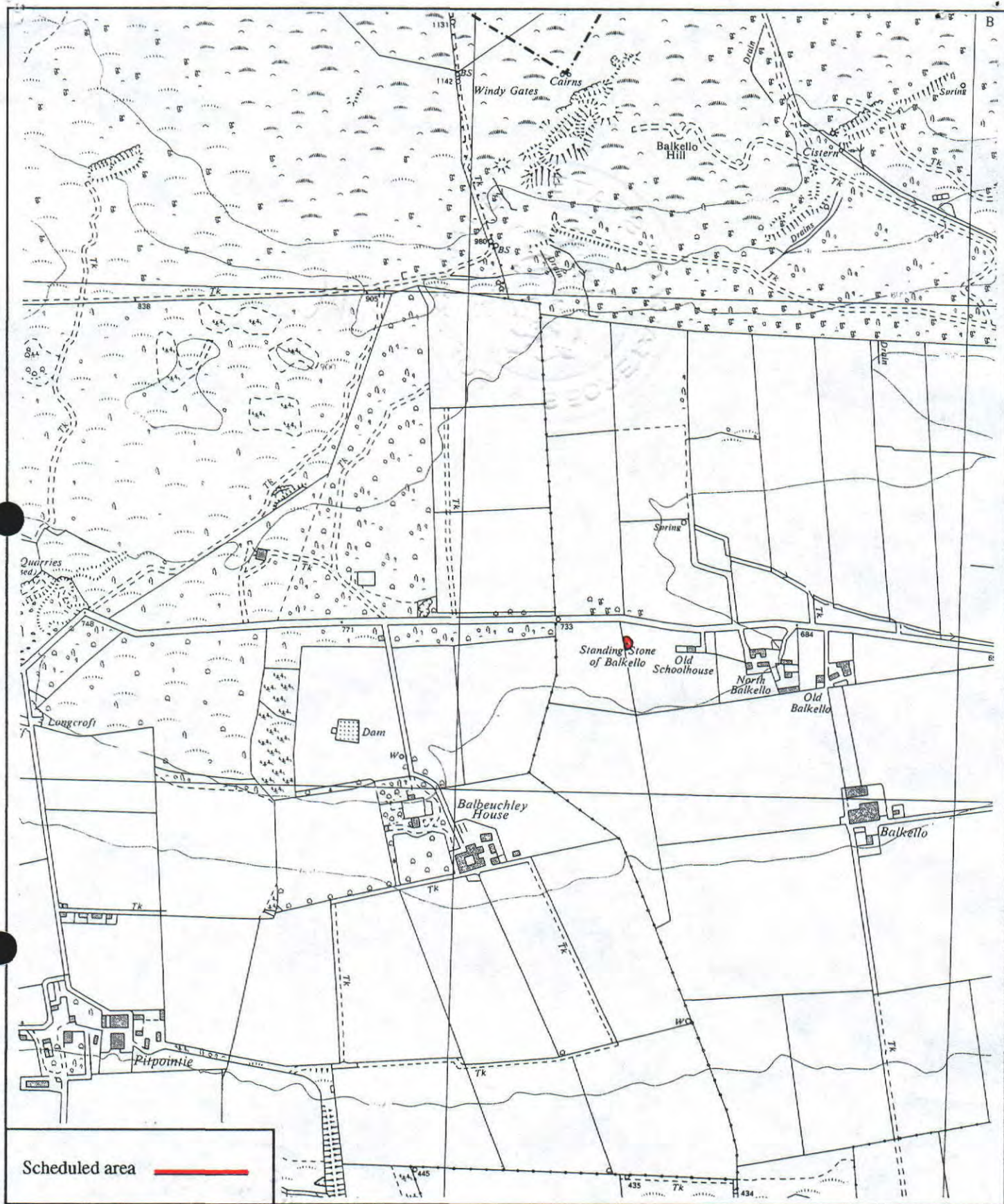

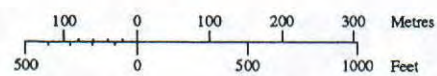
Balkello, standing stone
