THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Eilean Ghruididh, castle, Loch Maree comprises a natural island, fortified by an enclosure wall, forming an approximate rhomboid on plan, which lies about 150m from the S shore of Loch Maree. The area to be scheduled includes the whole island to the water's edge. It is irregular on plan and measures a maximum of 75m N-S by 60m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Gairloch and the County of Ross and Cromarty as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which

is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.




