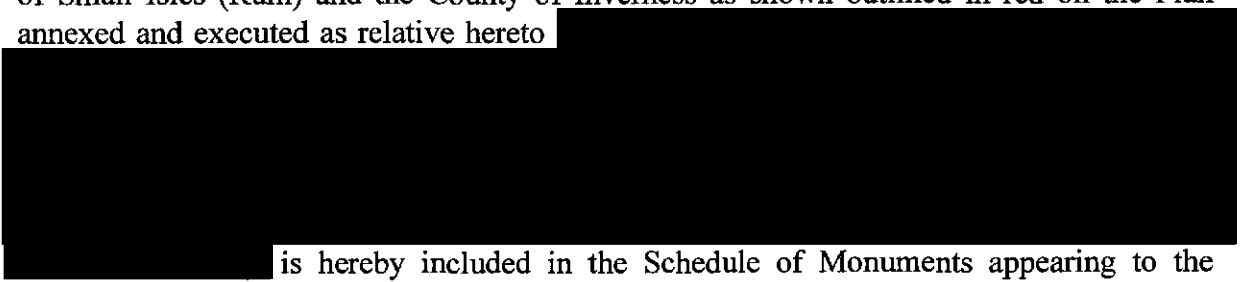

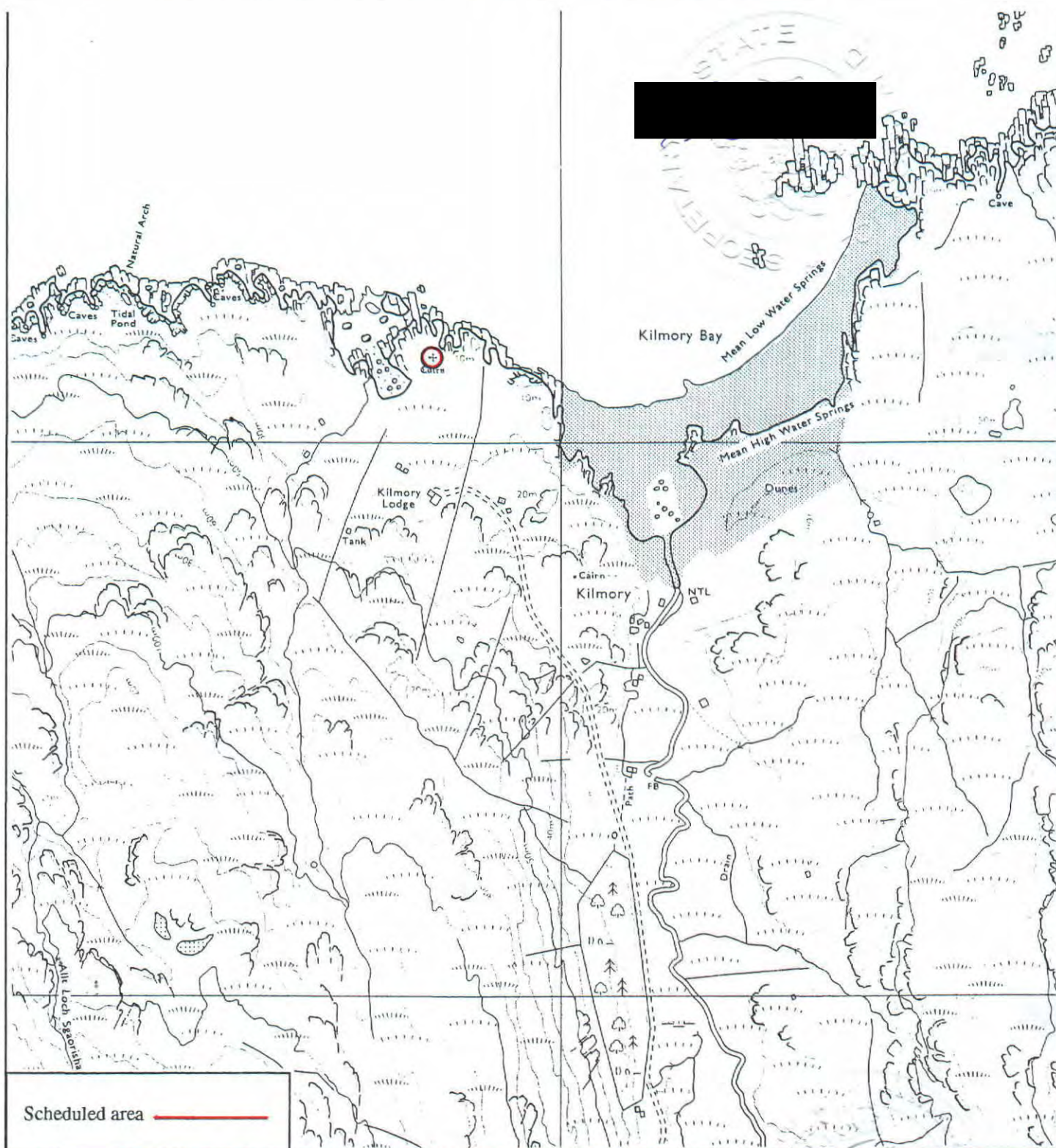

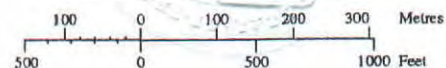
Kilmory Lodge, cairn 250m N of
