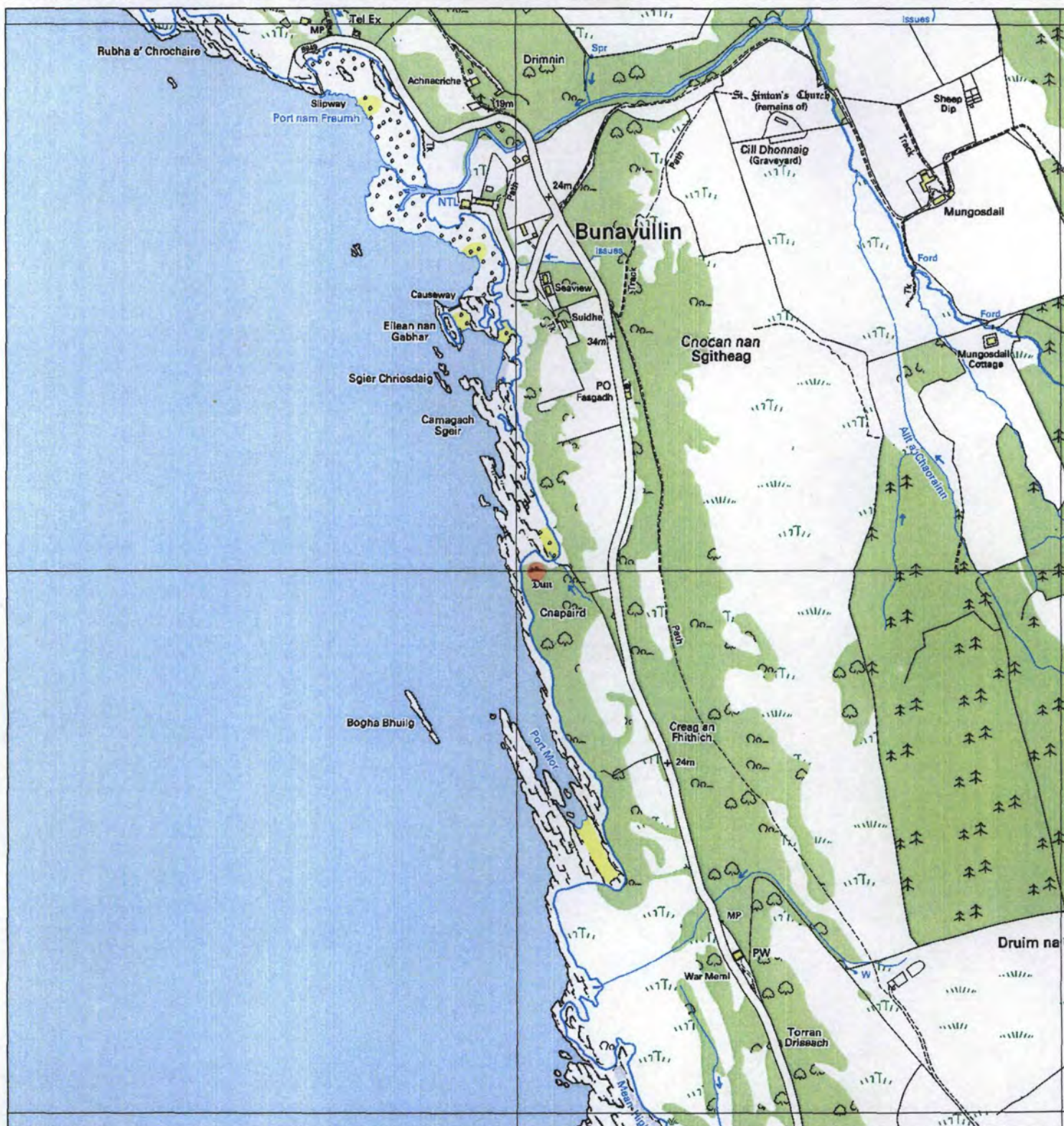
The monument known as Mungosdail Castle, dun, Cnapaird, 550m S of Bonnavoulin, comprises a dun of prehistoric date. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. It is circular with a diameter of 35m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Morvern and the County of Argyll as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.
