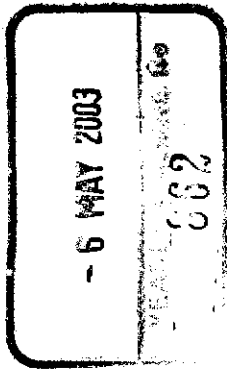

The monument known as Ardness, cairn 600m SSE of, comprises a cairn of prehistoric date, visible as a grass-covered mound on a small headland. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material is likely to survive. It is circular with a diameter of 35m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Morvern and the County of Argyll as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto
