

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as North Ballachulish, prehistoric ritual site NNE of Hotel comprises a group of archaeological features within and under the peat which forms the remaining part of North Ballachulish Moss. The area to be scheduled is irregular on plan, and measures a maximum of 280m N-S by 155m E-W, to include the Bronze Age platform, the stone cairn and an area around these in which remains of other structures and traces of activities connected with the construction and use of these structures are likely to survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Lochaber and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto


