

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Doune of Rothiemurchus, motte comprises an elongated mound traditionally held to be the site of a castle of the Comyn family. The area to be scheduled is approximately oval on plan, defined by the foot of the slope of the mound. It measures a maximum of 170m NE-SW by 110m. It is edged on the W and SW by an estate road and on the S by the back walls of ancillary buildings to the Doune, the inhabited house which is the vanished castle's successor. These features are excluded from scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Duthill and Rothiemurchus and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and

is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.
