Historic Scotland Longmore House Salisbury Place Edinburgh The monument known as Dornoch Cathedral, graveyard, comprises the medieval and later graveyard of Dornoch Cathedral, which includes the possible site of the early Christian St Finnbarr's Church. The monument is situated at 10m OD in the centre of the small town of Dornoch. The area to be scheduled comprises the entire graveyard, including the graveyard walls, in which archaeological evidence is likely to survive. It is irregular with maximum dimensions of 122m E-W by 42m N-S. The surfaces of all existing paths, to a depth of 30cm, are excluded from the scheduling to allow for routine maintenance. Dornoch Cathedral itself is in use as an ecclesiastical building and is also excluded from the scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Dornoch and the County of Sutherland as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.


