THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Corragan Mor, fort, Eigg, comprises the remains of a fortified settlement on a craggy knoll on the hillside below Eigg's eastern cliffs. The area to be scheduled is circular, 70m in diameter, to include the whole of the knoll on which the fort stands and an area around it. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Small Isles and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part

is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.


