The monument known as Creach Bheinn, survey camp and cairn, comprises the remains of a campsite, constructed by soldiers of the Ordnance Survey early in the 19<sup>th</sup> century as part of the first triangulation of Scotland. It is situated near the summit of Creach Bheinn at around 850m OD in open rocky grassland. The area to be scheduled has a figure of eight plan, formed by the junction of two circles, one 100m in diameter and the second 70m in diameter. Within the larger, northern part are the stone building, windbreak walls and three of the stone tent circles. Within the southern part of the area are the triangulation station and the fourth stone tent circle. Both areas include all of the features described plus the original footpath and an area around them in which evidence relating to their construction and occupation is likely to survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Ardnamurchan and the County of Argyll as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and

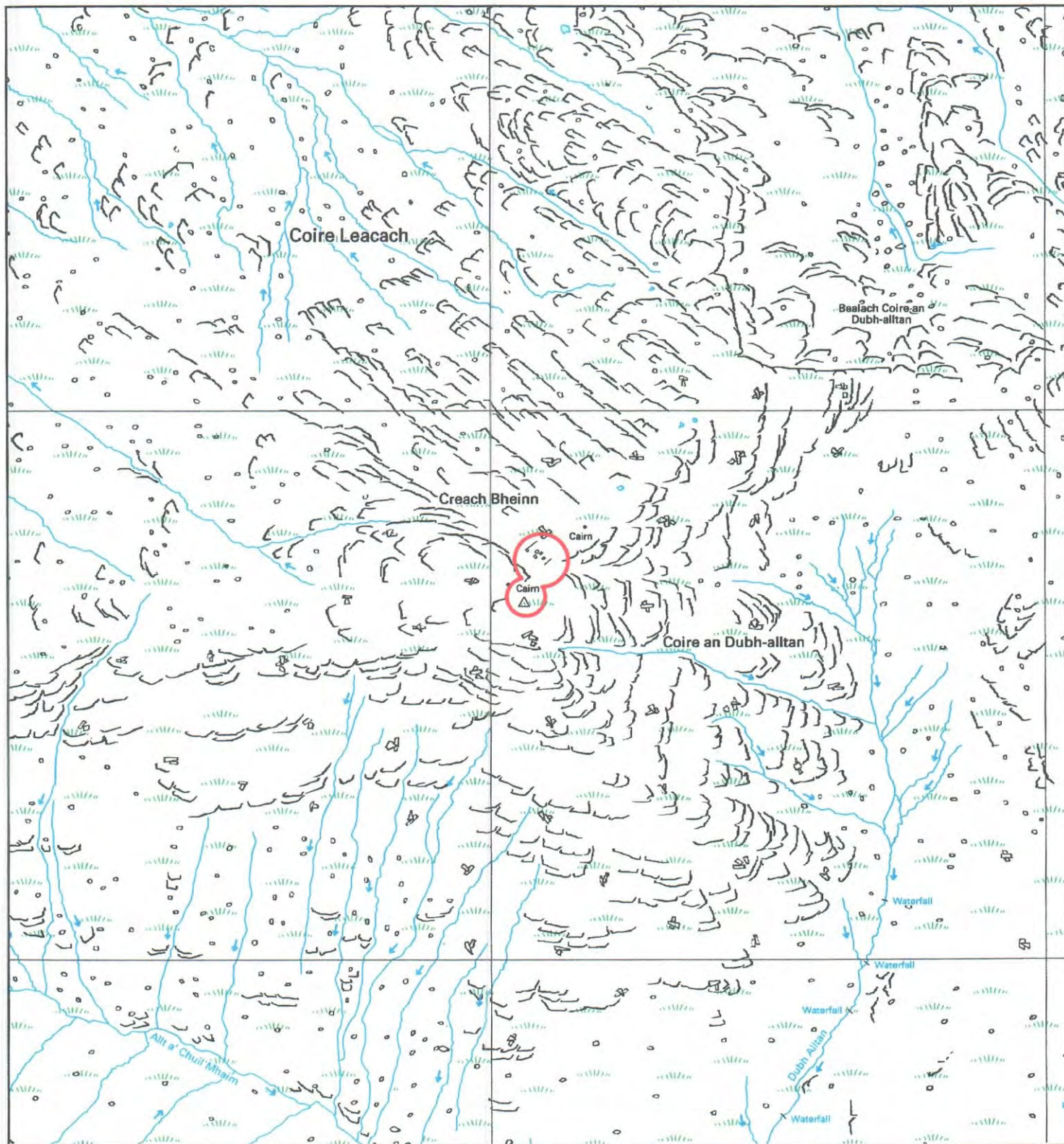
