The monument known as Rait Castle, enclosure 320m NE of, comprises a bivallate, roughly circular enclosure. It lies in arable land 3km SSE of Nairn at a height of 60m above sea level. The area to be scheduled is circular, to include an area around in which evidence relating to its construction and use of the site may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Nairn and the County of Nairn as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

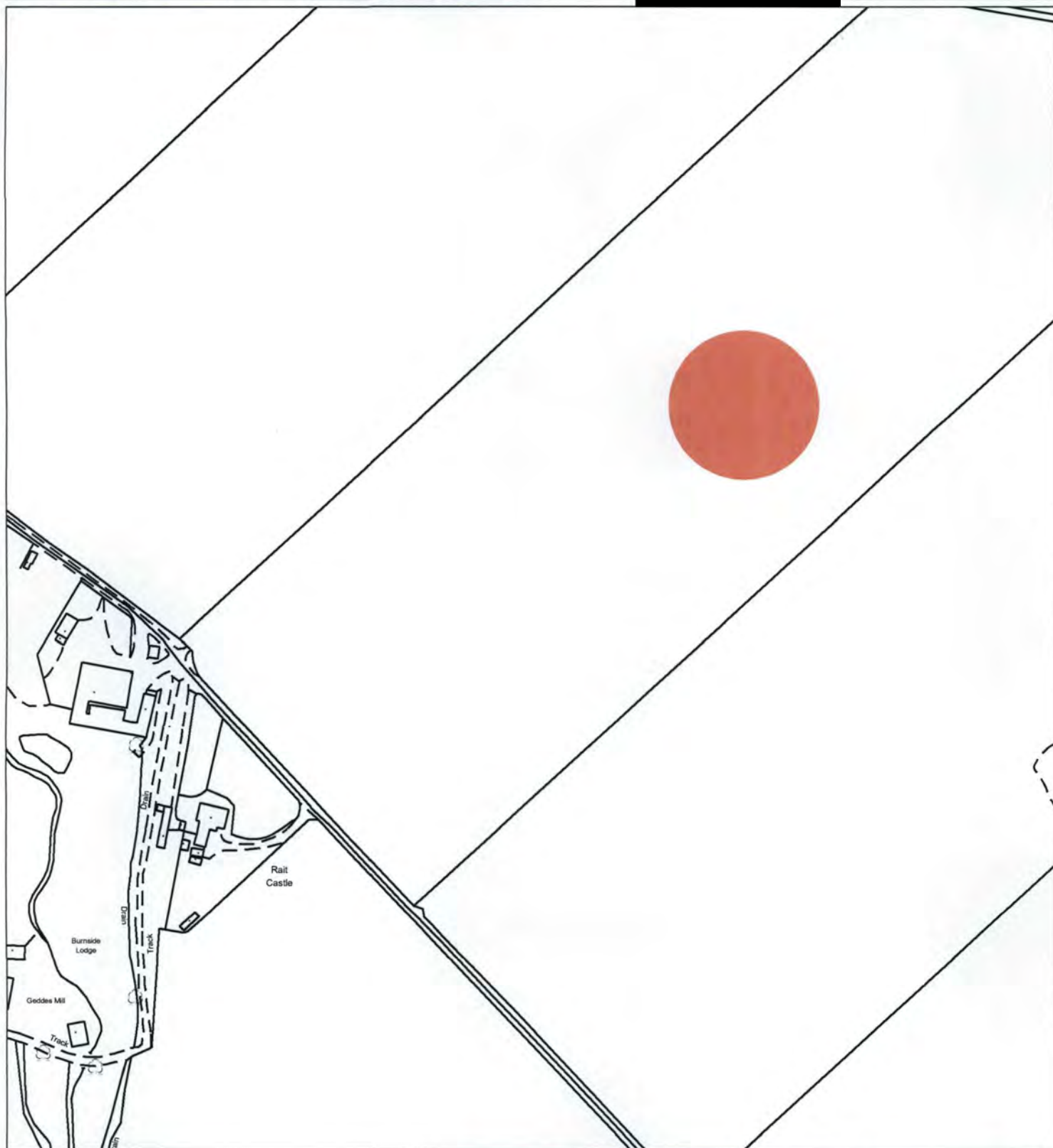

Scheduled Area

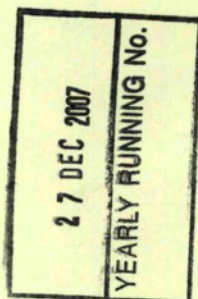
