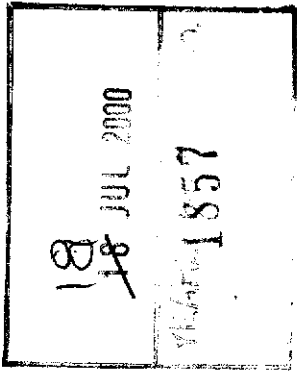

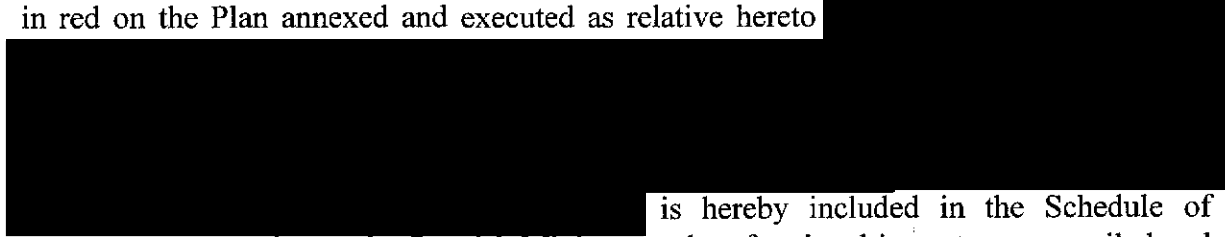

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Balvenie Castle comprises the remains of a castle of 13th to 16th century date. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. It is irregular with maximum dimensions of 120m from its northernmost point to its southernmost point and 170m from its easternmost point to its westernmost point, bounded for most of its perimeter by a fence, the above ground elements of which are excluded from the rescheduling. Also excluded from the scheduling is the modern building erected as a custodian's hut and the top 30cm of the modern road and car park surfaces to allow for maintenance. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Mortlach and the County of Banff as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

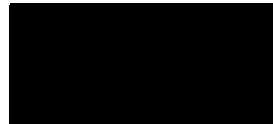

This is the plan referred to in the entry in the Schedule affecting, Balvenie Castle dated 3 November 1999 and is signed as relative thereto.



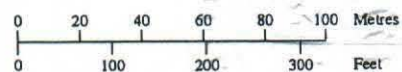
Balvenie Castle
