The monument known as Cairnpapple Hill, prehistoric ceremonial complex comprises a ceremonial complex of prehistoric date on the summit of Cairnpapple Hill. The area to be scheduled encompasses the area in state care and the area formerly scheduled, together with an area around this, beyond the upstanding elements of the monument, in which traces of associated ritual activity may be expected to survive. It is irregular in shape with maximum dimensions of 280m NE-SW by 215m as marked in red on the accompanying map. Aboveground modern features associated with the radio mast and its compound, and other aboveground modern features as they exist at the date of this scheduling extension, are excluded from the scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Torphichen and the County of West Lothian as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto




