## THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Drumtroddan, three standing stones SE of High Park Plantation comprises an alignment of three standing stones of prehistoric date. The middle stone has fallen and now lies prostrate. The upright stones stand about 13m apart aligned NE-SW. Both measure about 3m tall. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. It is rectangular with maximum dimensions of 34m from its northernmost point to its southernmost point and 34m from its easternmost point to its westernmost point. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Mochrum and the County of Wigtown as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of

is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.


